Oak Ridge/Summerfield Home Sales down -1.3% in First Quarter of 2019

Stokesdale home sales dip 8% from first quarter 2018 to first quarter 2019.

GREENSBORO (April 15, 2019) – There were 78 single-family home closings in Oak Ridge/Summerfield for the first quarter of 2019, a 1.3% decrease from a year earlier, while the median home price rose +10.2% (\$355,000 to \$391,162) and available inventory of homes dipped -4.4% (159 to 152), according to data compiled by the Greensboro Regional REALTORS® Association.

In Stokesdale, the number of closed sales for single-family homes was 23 closings in the first quarter of 2019. The median home price climbed +7.1% (\$189,000 to \$202,409), and inventory dropped -21.3% (61 to 68) over the first quarter of 2018.

"Home prices stayed on their course of measured growth, while the inventory of available homes remains tight throughout Guilford County and the Triad as a whole.
