This year, the REALTORS® will be working on one home located at **3620 Holts Chapel Road** in eastern Greensboro. Work days will start at approximately 8:30 a.m. and run until about 3:30 p.m.

More details on the home:

**3620 Holts Chapel Road** – home repair for an 82 and 84-year-old homeowner, plus their great-grandchild. REALTOR® volunteers will be trimming the back bushes and landscaping to prepare for painting, paint the home’s exterior siding, gables ends and fascia, raking and trimming landscaping, installing a side porch and stair railings, plus installing a front porch and stair railings to make their home more accessible. Community Housing Solutions will also replace the roof using a subcontractor, replacing the kitchen sink drain lines and traps using a plumber, repairing and replacing the subfloor in the living room, kitchen and bathroom.
